

Tools and Technology (T2) Examples

Introduction

The tools and technology (T2) file provides information on tools, information technology, software, equipment, and machines that workers need to perform successfully on the job. The information is comprehensive, but not exhaustive. Emphasis is placed on cutting edge technologies and emerging workplace practices. Examples of tools and technology used within each occupation are organized into a standardized taxonomy (i.e., the United Nations Standard Products and Service Code - UNSPSC), allowing for cross-occupational comparisons and analysis.

O*NET-SOC 2009 taxonomy

Note: these files are based on the O*NET-SOC 2009 taxonomy, which is used by O*NET database releases 14.0 and later. If you use these files with O*NET 13.0 or earlier, you may notice differences in occupational codes and titles. File Structure

Each file in the Tools and Technology package is described in this document. A list of columns is included, showing the column name used in the file, its data type, and a description of the column content. A description and data example for each file are also included.

The data types specified in the file structures are ANSI (American National Standards Institute) compliant. The following data types are used in this document:

Character:	fixed-length character string
Character Varying:	varying-length string
Integer:	whole number

Each file contains tab delimited fields in the above data types.

This file contains the Tools and Technology examples associated with O*NET-SOC occupations. Each example is classified in two ways: the column “T2 Type” indicates whether the example is a tool or a technology (software product), and the columns “Commodity Code” and “Commodity Title” classify the example under the United Nations Standard Products and Services Code (UNSPSC). The UNSPSC is described in further detail in the next section.

The file contains 6 tab delimited fields, identified using the column names provided above. The 6 fields are represented by one row. There are a total of 43,848 rows of data in this file.

This file contains a listing of commodities in the United Nations Standard Products and Services Code (UNSPSC), version 6.1101. The UNSPSC is a four-level taxonomy for the classification of products and services, provided by the United Nations Development Programme; more information can be found at the UNSPSC web site (<http://www.unspsc.org/>). In the taxonomy, the Segment is the most general element and the Commodity is the most specific. One example is listed below:

Segment: 41000000 Laboratory and Measuring and Observing and Testing Equipment
Family: 41110000 Measuring and observing and testing instruments
Class: 41116200 Patient point of care testing supplies and equipment
Commodity: 41116201 Glucose monitors or meters

Each T2 example is classified under this taxonomy; the “Commodity Code” and “Commodity Title” columns in the Tools and Technology file can be used as a cross-reference into this file.

The file contains 8 tab delimited fields, identified using the column names provided above. The 8 fields are represented by one row. There are a total of 2,888 rows of data in this file.
