Ability.txt	<p>Change the sample size N to 8 for all Abilities with a Domain Source of “Analyst”. 29,120 total rows match this criteria.</p> <p>Due to a data processing error, the Abilities metadata added since the 6.0 database release (July 2004) onward reported an incorrect sample size for new analyst data. In the incorrect file, sample size N varied between 0 and 8 for Importance data, and was listed as “n/a” for Level data. In all cases, the sample size N should have been reported as 8. The sample size for 5.1 data (March 2003) was reported correctly.</p> <p>Abilities ratings data, and other metadata such as the “Recommend Suppress” and “Not Relevant” flags, are unaffected by this error. Only developers and researchers who use the sample size metadata are impacted.</p>

Tasks.txt	<p>Remove 2 duplicate tasks from occupation 25-1052.00 (Chemistry Teachers, Postsecondary).</p> <p>Task statements 20 and 21 for this occupation were duplicates of tasks 24 and 26, respectively. (There was a minor grammatical difference between task 20 and task 24.) The earlier instances of these statements were removed.
