

## Supplemental file to the O\*NET 4.0 Database      March 4, 2002

### Introduction:

This document provides a reference to the related\_occupation\_data file. A list of columns is included, showing the column name used in the file, its data type, and the full name of its content. The data type is taken from the Oracle database management system (DBMS) : VARCHAR2, varying-length string. A description and data example from the file follow the list of columns. This information is provided to describe the data in this file only. It does not represent a database structure, but enables a database developer to pick and choose columns for database field and table creation with a database management system (DBMS) of choice.

### Related Occupation Data

**Purpose:** The data in this release contains Related Occupation data. Related Occupations displays a list of related jobs that have similar characteristics

**File Name:** related\_occupation\_data

The data in this file represented the mapping of each O\*NET-SOC code to its related occupations, in the form of O\*NET-SOC codes. They are displayed in two (2) tab delimited fields with the columns named O\*NET-SOC Code and Related O\*NET-SOC Code. Each of the two (2) fields is represented by 1 row (line of text). There are a total of 6,397 records or rows of data in this file.
